1. Dance Program Calendar

Each of the Dance Program students will be expected to sell at least 2 calendars. They will be sold for \$15. Individual prints will also be sold at a price of \$10 for a 5x7 and \$15 for an 8x10. Douglas indicated that the calendars would be available on December 7. They will be distributed to the Dance Program students on December 8. Another date will be identified to sell the calendar in front of the cafeteria to other Canterbury students. The calendar will be part of the acceptance package sent to students accepted into next year's Grade 9 class.

Action: Douglas will prepare a poster advertising the sale of the calendar and Connie St. Louis will make photocopies so it can be posted around the school. Wendy will prepare a newsletter to Dance Program parents about the calendar. Volunteers will be sought to sell the calendar to the Dance Program students during lunch on December 8 and to other Canterbury students during lunch on another day before Christmas.

6. **Roundtable**

Fabyenne reported that they had not been able to locate a suitable venue for the flashmob so it would not be scheduled before Christmas. The possibility of posting a video on YouTube to tell participants the date and venue of the flashmob and to teach the participants the flashmob dance was discussed. It could be done downtown on a Saturday and participation would be voluntary.

Action: AJ Innocente and Tenzin will follow-up with Sierra and Alix who are coordinating the flashmob.
