**5. Roundtable**

Fabyenne indicated that the Board preferred schools to use agents to arrange trips such as the Grade 12 field trip. An itinerary should be prepared and sent to the agent who would then give the school a price. The trip would include all the Grade 12 students as well as three Grade 12 students in the Grade 11 dance class. The field trip would be on February 16-17, just before the PD day on February 18. Funds raised at the Trios and Quartets in March would be used for the Grade 11 Cornwall trip so the funds currently in the account could be used for the Grade 12 field trip. The flashmob discussed at the previous DPC meeting would probably not happen although the Grade 11 student representatives at the meeting proposed that the students work together and then come to the faculty with their ideas.
